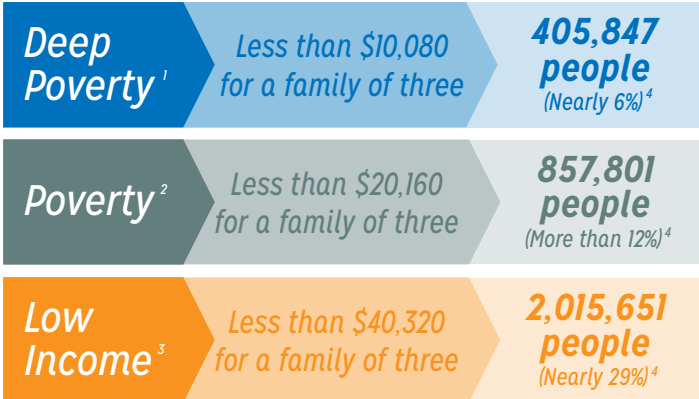

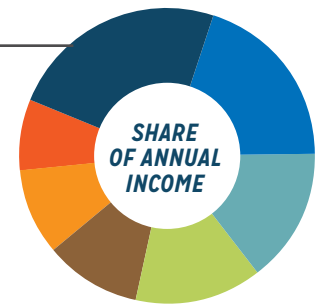
MANY HOUSEHOLDS STRUGGLE TO MEET BASIC NEEDS

Other	\$4,880

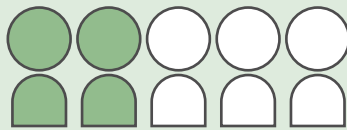
